Welcome to 2022 and welcome to all the families that purchased homes this past year in the Horn Rapids community. Our community continues to grow with the Quail Ridge division currently under development. There are currently 1279 living units in Horn Rapids.

This past year has once again been one of many challenges. COVID-19 restrictions have continued to prevent us from conducting in-person board meetings. In an effort to improve community input and communication, our two resident board members and all of the HOA management team will be conducting HOA owner in-person meetings quarterly in 2022. This will provide all owners a forum to address questions and concerns directly to the HOA staff and the board members who live in Horn Rapids. It will also allow the staff to communicate the status of projects and issues that affect all of us in Horn Rapids.

In addition, pool use was restricted for the first half of the season and many planned reserve and capital projects were not completed due to contractor backlogs.

We also saw the passing of the torch on the Social Committee from Karen Harper to Ashley Abell. On January 1, 2022, we welcomed Ksenia (Susha) Akimova to the team as our new webmaster, replacing Jessica Schumacher. We thank Jessica for her contributions to the HOA.

The board consists of seven members, two of which are Horn Rapids owners. Jerry Beach was appointed in 2019 to fill a vacated position and Tom Harper was elected to his position by the November annual ballot with his term commencing January 1, 2022.

Our team is committed to managing to the standards set forth in our HOA governing documents and ask that each of you do your part in helping this community maintain those standards.

RULES & REGULATION REPORT

Greetings to all our wonderful Horn Rapids Homeowners in our golfing community. I am going to start off the new year with a joke for all those in our golfing community!!! Now on to business! The Rules and Regulations Enforcement Committee worked diligently in 2021 and observed many violations while driving around in our lovely community, plus homeowners brought violations to our attention and we addressed those violations as quickly as we could. By using our AppFolio system we were able to immediately send out email violation notices with photos attached addressing the issues in a timely manner resulting in homeowners getting back into compliance with the HOA Rules and Regulations and CC&Rs.

As a reminder, it is joint effort. We need to continue to work as a team to do our part in keeping our homes in the Horn Rapids community looking beautiful, so please review and continue to follow the Rules and Regulations, CC&R's, Architectural Guidelines and Bylaws of the Horn Rapids Master Homeowners Association. If you have not read and would like a better understanding of all the current rules and regulation and CC&R's these documents are accessible on the hornrapidshoa.com website.

Here is an overview of the number of Rules and Regulations & CC&R's violations the RR&E Committee sent out and resolved in 2021: As you can see, yard maintenance and recreation vehicles parked in front of homes over 72 hours were to the two biggest violations we addressed last year.

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If any homeowners are interested in being an enforcement officer on the Rules, Regulations and Enforcement Committee on a volunteer basis we could really use your help. It is simple, we help homeowners by reminding them of the rules and regulations for our community. With our new enforcement compliance system, there are no more knocking on doors and addressing homeowner face-to-face, you just send out a violation email and you can remain anonymous if you would like. 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ARCHITECTURAL CONTROL COMMITTEE (ACC) REPORT —

The Master Homeowners Association wants to remind all homeowners that Post-Construction changes to homes and yards require review by the ACC before the project is started. The ACC reviews post-construction additions and changes to ensure compliance with community standards and MHA covenants. When you have your plan made, please complete the ACC application, attach your plans, and get them to the ACC Chairman – Bernie Femreite (375-0250). The application form is in the homeowners manual, on the Horn Rapids website, or Bernie can provide you one. You may get assistance or advice from any of the committee members.

For the 12 months ending Oct.1, 2021, the AC Committee reviewed and approved 145 project applications, ranging from repainting, to fences, to landscaping, etc. We also advised several owners regarding maintenance projects and revisions to projects which otherwise would not have been approved. We had one revoked project application, due to incoror which enforcement action was taken – it was brought into compliance. One "freelance" project was stopped for improper installation and lack of ACC review, which was restarted with revisions and ACC approval. Generally, there have been fewer "freelance" projects this last year; it seems better communication with owners is getting favorable results.

The Committee had one resignation during the year, due to a transfer. Tom Bratvold resigned after some 12 years of service on the Committee. The vacancy was advertised in the community and two well-qualified candidates were asked to join the Committee:

COMMON GROUNDS REPORT

A little reflection on a very challenging Common Grounds season.

From a second winter drought to a front entrance pond algae infestation and lastly a summer heat wave. All added consequences that required extraordinary effort and changes for the future. Again I want to thank the crew from Heritage for their support in managing and minimizing the effects of these extreme conditions.

The drought caused us to remove 14–16 mature trees and place another 18–20 on a watch for next year. Next year we will up our tree plant back program to replace and supplement some of our loses. The pond algae infestation in May and June was shocking in its size and onset speed but we eliminated it with two applications of a new chemical. In June the record setting temperatures started into motion the conditions creating the worst weed infestation in over a decade. Unfortunately our single program herbicide application, though usually effective, wasn't enough to control the weeds and crab grass through the summer. Next year we're going to add another application in the spring to supplement the program June application.

On a happy note, the Quail Ridge development progressed to a point where we added a second walkway loop route. A couple priority projects for the 2022 season include the much needed walkway asphalt repairs in the spring, several improvements to the front entrance pond and round-about areas and the start of program to refresh some of our older neighborhood monuments. I would like to thank the home ownership for their continued support, feedback and patience.
